

The Gdańsk Christmas Fair is officially open. A Winter Pageant and the first performance of the Bugle Call

A procession of beautifully festive winter characters, the premiere of the Bugle Call and a speech by Deputy Mayor of Gdańsk Piotr Grzelak to conclude the Opening Ceremony: the Gdańsk Christmas Fair lit up the Coal Market (Targ Węglowy) on Saturday afternoon. It was a splendid invitation to Celebrate in Gdańsk with the exhibitors and visitors alike.

The beautifully festive winter parade started off in Tkacka St. towards Długa St. to make its way through the Golden Gate to the Coal Market and on to the stage. The fairy-tale pageant put the Fair's visitors in a magical mood. Stilt walkers and actors from the Gdańsk Archipelago of Culture (GAK) Theatre acted out genre scenes, engaging passers-by in the Opening Ceremony parade. The Christmas-themed characters were accompanied by children from two artistic and creative teams of the Youth Centre (Pałac Młodzieży) and children from the Gdańsk Archipelago of Culture Song and Dance Ensemble (ZPiT GAK). All this took place with the assistance from the Gdańsk Garrison, the Taraban band and an instrumental ensemble.

When the pageant reached the stage, which is located next to the Wybrzeże Theatre this year—in a way that does not obscure the Theatre's beautiful, renovated façade—the Opening Ceremony began. The popular favourites, Mr and Mrs Nutcracker, were already waiting there. Children's music bands, Superband and Smile, created a fairy-tale atmosphere, and so did Dorenutki and the GAK dance ensemble during the ceremony. The public was introduced to each part of the event by Silver Lady Winter and Praline Snow Maiden.

One of the main parts of the Opening Ceremony was the presentation of the Gdańsk Christmas Fair Bugle Call. This year, a competition was announced for a piece to become the leitmotif of the preholiday event. It was co-organised by the Gdańsk Academy of Music. Without knowing the composers of the pieces beforehand, the judging panel was delighted with the work of Magdalena Garbecka. The Gdańsk Academy of Music graduate won first prize, PLN 4,000, and the bugle call she composed will be played on every day of the Fair. It premiered on Saturday afternoon, performed by students of the Gdańsk Academy of Music.

"The idea for the Christmas Fair Bugle Call was initiated by the Rector of the Gdańsk Academy of Music, Ryszard Minkiewicz. There was a big discussion about it. St Dominic's Fair has its own bugle call which adds a note every year so why not try it at the Christmas Fair? Now I can say that the piece surprised me in a good way. A big thank you to Magdalena and the Academy," says Andrzej Bojanowski, President of the Management Board, MTG SA Gdańsk International Fair Co.

More than one composition could be submitted to the Christmas Fair Bugle Call competition. As a result, 2nd and 3rd place went to Szymon Janiszewski, who received PLN 3,000 and PLN 1,500, respectively. A total of 7 composers participated.

The 2023 Gdańsk Christmas Fair was ceremoniously opened by Deputy Mayor of Gdańsk Piotr Grzelak.

"I am glad that, as every year, we meet at the Coal Market during one of Europe's most beautiful Christmas markets. Last year, many thousands of online votes resulted in the Gdańsk Fair being considered the second most beautiful in Europe. We have 150 exhibitors, including 50 from Gdańsk. However, it is worth adding that we have exhibitors from all over the world. Let's enjoy ourselves, visit the stalls, smell the beautiful Christmas scents and taste the best delicacies," said Deputy Mayor of Gdańsk Piotr Grzelak.

A moment after the Deputy Mayor's speech, the procession of festive winter characters set off to the Coal Market and Bogusławskiego St. to continue celebrating the launch of the Fair together with the visitors.

Zakład Utylizacyjny (Waste Disposal Plant) in Gdańsk was the partner of the 2023 Christmas Fair Opening Ceremony.

You can admire the beautiful festive arrangement of the Fair owing to, among others, the Polish State Forests, the provider of the Christmas trees. This is why the Coal Market has turned green and become Christmas-scented right since Day 1.

Get to know the programme of the Gdańsk Christmas Fair

The Opening Ceremony was the first item on the wide-ranging artistic agenda which fills almost every day of the Fair. **On Tuesdays**, music fans can listen to Christmas concerts, featuring the Slavic Soul Christmas Band, Gospel Carol Singing and Carol Singing with the GUMed Choir. **On Wednesdays**, visitors can grab microphones and sing the most beautiful Polish and international Christmas hits at Christmas Karaoke. **On Thursdays**, there will be surprises to please the eye—the Fire Theatre and parades—as well as the ear: Fairy Tales read with the Wybrzeże Theatre and the Voivodship & Municipal Public Library. **On Fridays**, the organisers invite kids to activities with the Wykrzyknik (Exclamation Mark) Academy of Fun and Education, and older participants to an evening dance with festive DJ sets. **On Saturdays**, there will be a Christmas medley: performances by the Gdańsk Song & Dance Ensemble and the Neptune Song & Dance Ensemble, and the Winter Adventure with Treflik.

As always, the Fair will be visited by Santa Claus and the official mascots of the event, Mr and Mrs Nutcracker, who are just waiting to have snapshots taken with visitors and record Christmas greetings. **Sundays are time** for loved ones. Children and their parents can watch performances and take part in activities organised by the Qfer Theatre, listen to carolling with Carillon and have fun with Caritas, which will promote volunteering and the joy of sharing kindness.

From 1 December, together with the E.Wedel confectionery company, we invite you to the opening of the windows of the Advent Calendar, which, as always, will become part of the Advent Gate.
